Who is eligible for the state convention?

Anyone who votes in the March 6 Republican primary election in Williamson County, whether on election day, by mail, or during early voting. It is not required to attend the county convention in order to be elected as a delegate/alternate to the state convention.

How much are Party Dues?

Dues are \$25 family / \$15 individual per year, and can be mailed payable to WCRP, PO Box 393, Round Rock, TX 78680. Dues for prior years will also be gladly accepted.

Who should fill out this application?

Everyone who wants to be considered for the state convention. Even if you are well-known as a hard worker and every committee member knows you, they still need to know who is available and interested in going to the convention in May.

How much detail do I need to provide?

That really depends on how well you are known by party leadership and senior activists who will be serving on the nominations committee. In general, if you have not been active in the Williamson County Republican Party for long, and have not served as a delegate to the state convention from Williamson County, it is in your best interest to provide as much information about you as possible so the Nominations Committee can make an educated and informed decision.

How should the application be turned in?

The application can be dropped off at party headquarters (716 S Rock St, Georgetown TX, 78626), Faxed to 512-590-8689, mailed to the party PO Box, given to Chairman Fairbrother at any political event, or scanned and emailed to info@williamsoncountygop.org . In order to achieve maximum consideration, please return the application by March 10 if possible.

Should alternate delegates attend the state convention? YES! It is a longstanding practice in Williamson County to make sure every alternate delegate has an opportunity to be seated as a delegate at some point during the convention and fully participate in the proceedings. Alternate delegates have the same access to receptions, exhibits, and other activities. They do, however, have a separate seating area for caucuses and the general sessions.

Who should interview in person?

New volunteers and activists are encouraged to appear in person before the nominations committee. This generally means anyone who was not a delegate to the 2016 Republican Party of Texas State Convention from Williamson County.

The temporary nominations committee will be conducting interviews before the county convention. Please consult the web page or Facebook page for information about these meetings. Meeting times and locations will be posted by March 8th. Those new to the Williamson County Republican Party are strongly encouraged to meet with the nominations committee before the county convention. **There will be a very limited amount of time for interviews at the county convention.**
